2006 Bodega Montevejejo Lindaflor Malbec
93+ Pts Wine Advocate
93 Pts TANZER

2006 Lindaflor Malbec is 100% varietal aged for 18 months in new French oak. It offers up an ethereal aromatic array of wood smoke, pencil lead, lavender, spice box, black cherry, and black raspberry that is already remarkably complex. On the palate it is dense, rich, and opulent with layers of savory black fruits, exotic spices, and enough structure to evolve for at least 5-7 years. Cellar it for a minimum of five years and enjoy it through 2030.



2007 Bodega Montevejejo Lindaflor Chardonnay
90 Points Wine Advocate

The 2007 Lindaflor Chardonnay is medium gold-colored with an attractive bouquet of toast, butterscotch, apple, poached pear, and pineapple. Full-bodied and smooth-textured, it has plenty of ripe fruit, excellent concentration and balancing acidity. Drink this lengthy effort over the next two years. It is an outstanding value.

The opaque purple-colored 2006 Montevejejo is composed of 60% Malbec, 20% Syrah, 10% Merlot, and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon aged for 16 months in new French oak. It exhibits an expressive perfume of pain grille, pencil lead, lavender, black cherry, blueberry, and licorice. On the palate it is full-bodied, dense, and layered. It has that extra dimension of complexity that is the result of an exceptional vintage as well as enough ripe tannin to develop for another 3-4 years. It should provide immense pleasure between 2012 and 2026.

2006 Bodega Poesia Clos des Andes Reserva

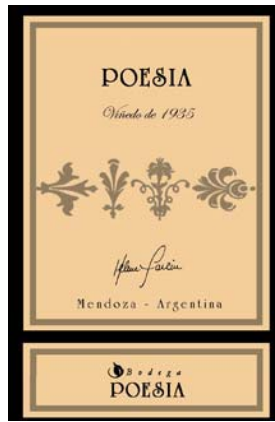

The 2006 Clos des Andes is 100% Malbec sourced from an 80-year-old vineyard in Lujan de Cuyo and aged for 12 months in 50% new French oak. Dark ruby/purple in color, it offers up an alluring bouquet of pain grille, pencil lead, spice box, and black cherry. This leads to a wine with excellent density, layered fruit, and spicy black fruit flavors nicely concealing enough structure for 2-3 years of further development. This rich, well-balanced effort will be at its best from 2010 to 2019.

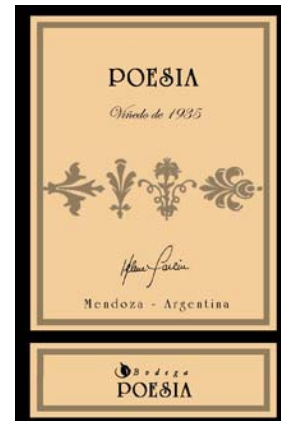
A barrel sample of the 2007 Clos des Andes reveals a wine with a similar personality. It is a bit more saturated in appearance but otherwise is a kissing cousin to the 2006.

The purple-colored 2006 Poesia, sourced from an 80-year-old vineyard in Lujan de Cuyo, was barrel fermented and aged for 18 months in new French oak. It is a blend of 60% Malbec and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon. It exhibits a brooding nose of smoky new oak, mineral, damp earth, black currant, black cherry, and blackberry followed by a plush, nearly opulent wine with great depth of fruit, complex flavors with notes of espresso and chocolate emerging on the palate, superb grip, and 5-7 years of aging potential. Drink this superb effort from 2013 to 2030.



2007 Bodega Poesia Pasodoble

The crimson-colored 2007 Paso Doble is a blend of 30% Malbec, 30% Syrah, 20% Bonarda, and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon aged for 12 months in French oak, 20% new. The nose reveals cedar, spice box, pepper, blueberry, and black cherry. Medium to full-bodied on the palate, the wine has plenty of spicy, savory fruit, good balance, and a forward personality. Drink this excellent value over the next four years.
